Instructions After Ear Piercing

Clean around the studs both in front and back of the ears using a cotton ball moistened with rubbing alcohol. Do not remove the gold studs used to pierce the ears for six weeks. Continue to wear simple studs or light weight earrings for the next six weeks. Earrings should not be removed for long periods of time so that the holes do not close up. Heavier and dangling earrings can be worn three months after piercing. If the ears become sore or irritated, these earring types should be removed and replaced with studs. If the holes should close up unexpectedly please call the office and speak to one of our nurses.

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
